

AbbVie Possibilities Scholarship - Fact Sheet

What

The AbbVie Possibilities Scholarship Program offers scholarships to help children of employees achieve their full potential through post-secondary education.

About

- Awards are offered worldwide for study at two- or four-year colleges and universities (or equivalent) as well as vocational/technical and trade schools.
- Awards are for undergraduate study only and are for a student's first degree.
- In the U.S., eligible full-time enrollment will be 12 or more credit hours per semester.
- For outside the U.S., eligible full-time enrollment is at the discretion of the university, college or trade school.

AbbVie Employee Requirements

- Must have a minimum of one year of employment with AbbVie and be an active, benefits eligible employee with a minimum of 20 scheduled work hours per week.
- Grade 22 and below for legacy AbbVie, Grade 14 and below for legacy Allergan.

Eligibility

Student Requirements

- Must be age 26 or under.
- Must be in their final year of upper secondary school/high school seniors or current undergraduate students at the time of application.
- Must be an AbbVie employee's biological or legally adopted child, including of a domestic partner, foster children and stepchildren.

Amount

The specific dollar amounts depend on the degree program the student is pursuing.*

- Up to \$2,500 for 2 year, associate's degree, vocational/technical and trade programs
- Up to \$5,000 for 4 year, bachelor's degree programs

Considerations include academic performance; demonstrated leadership and participation in school and community activities; work experience; statement of career and educational goals and objectives; and brief essay.

Application Process

Academic evaluation of international applicants will include a review of the grade average based on the grading system used in the applicant's country and a review of the results of academic examinations.

Selection

Selection of recipients is made by Scholarship America, a highly regarded non-profit organization that designs and manages scholarship, tuition assistance and other education support programs for corporations, foundations, associations and individuals.

Scholarships are awarded annually. Applications are submitted directly to Scholarship America. **Application period will be open through April 15, 2021.**

Timing

COVID-19 NOTE: Scholarship America is committed to supporting student's needs during this uncertain time. Awards may be deferred for future semesters, if a student doesn't enroll for any reason, and may also be used for online courses. Please reach out with questions.
